Here, in the quiet cloisters, you'll walk in the footsteps of the monk whose spark of genius gave the world its most timeless celebration.

Dinner at Michelin-Starred Le Foch

At Le Foch, a Michelin-starred jewel in Reims, each plate arrives like a masterpiece. From seabass baked in Vallauris pottery to inventive seasonal creations, the artistry is matched only by the service.
