Option 1: Scenic Wonders & Picnic Lunch

Leave Banff behind and journey into the breathtaking wilderness of Yoho National Park, where every turn reveals another unforgettable view. With your private guide leading the way, discover towering peaks, emerald lakes, rushing rivers, and some of the Canadian Rockies' most iconic natural wonders.

Watch freight trains perform the remarkable feat of the Spiral Tunnels, marvel at the turquoise waters of the Kicking Horse River, and stand beside the Natural Rock Bridge, where centuries of rushing water have sculpted solid stone into a natural masterpiece. Continue through the spectacular Yoho Valley to Emerald Lake, where crystal-clear jade waters mirror the surrounding mountains, before arriving at the awe-inspiring Takakkaw Falls, where glacial water plunges more than 1,200 feet into the valley below.

Midway through your adventure, enjoy an included lunch surrounded by some of the most spectacular scenery in the Rockies—a chance to relax, take in the views, and savor the moment before continuing your journey.

Option 2: Adventure on Horseback & Foot

For those who crave a more active immersion into the Rockies, this adventure blends timeless tradition with natural wonder. Begin on horseback, the steady rhythm of hooves carrying you along winding trails through the Bow Valley, where towering pines frame meadows alive with wildflowers. Following riverside paths once traveled by explorers and ranchers, you'll cross the sparkling Bow River, its currents reflecting the endless sky. As you climb toward the flanks of Sulphur Mountain, the trail opens to sweeping vistas — snow-capped peaks layered against one another like brushstrokes on a canvas, stretching as far as the eye can see.

The journey continues on foot with a guided hike through Grotto Canyon, where silence is broken only by the crunch of gravel underfoot and the murmur of a hidden stream. Ancient rock walls rise dramatically on either side, their surfaces etched with Indigenous pictographs that whisper stories from centuries past. Time and water have polished the stone smooth, creating a corridor that feels both sacred and surreal. At every turn, your private guide enriches the journey with tales of geology, wildlife, and local culture — transforming the landscape into a living classroom of history and wonder. With private transfers included,

all you need to do is breathe in the crisp alpine air, embrace the thrill of exploration, and let the Canadian Rockies unfold their secrets with each step and stride.
