Edinburgh: History Around Every Corner

Your first three nights are spent in Edinburgh, where medieval spires, Georgian architecture, and lively pubs create one of Europe's most captivating cityscapes. Your stay at B+B Hotel Edinburgh (or similar) places you within easy reach of the city's celebrated landmarks, restaurants, and atmospheric streets.

Wander the cobblestones of the Royal Mile, duck into a centuries-old pub, or take in the dramatic skyline as Edinburgh Castle towers above the city. Here, history is not tucked away in museums; it surrounds you.

Edinburgh Castle: Step Into Scotland's Story

Perched dramatically atop Castle Rock, Edinburgh Castle has watched over the city for centuries. Cross through its ancient gates and enter a world of kings, queens, battles, and legends.

Your First Round: Golf in the Edinburgh Countryside

Your Scottish golf adventure begins with a round at your choice of Prestonfield Golf Club, Musselburgh Golf Club, or Gullane Golf Club's No. 2 or No. 3 Course.

Whichever course you choose, expect the character that makes Scottish golf unforgettable: rolling terrain, natural contours, coastal breezes, and holes that reward creativity as much as power. Feel the turf beneath your feet, study the wind before your next shot, and play the game in the country where it all began.

St. Andrews: Welcome to the Home of Golf

Next comes a name that needs little introduction, St. Andrews. There is something different about arriving here as a golfer. The sea air rolls in off the North Sea, historic stone buildings line the streets, and golf is everywhere: in the shops, the pubs, the conversations, and the generations of players who have traveled here before you.

For two nights, settle into the charm of Rufflets House Hotel (or similar). Surrounded by gardens and open countryside, this elegant country house sits a short distance from the heart of St. Andrews, and it makes a quiet place to unwind, recount the day's best shots, and take in the atmosphere of this legendary golf town.

Golf in St. Andrews: A Bucket-List Round

Now comes the moment golfers dream about, teeing it up in St. Andrews.

Choose your round on the New Course, Jubilee Course, Craigtoun Course, or Fairmont St Andrews' Torrance or Kittocks Course, each with its own distinctive test and unforgettable Scottish setting. Stand over your ball with the wind coming off the sea, take one last look down the fairway, and swing. This is more than another round for the scorecard; you are playing golf in the place that has shaped the game for generations.

When the final putt drops, there is only one thing left to do: raise a glass and toast a trip that carried you from Edinburgh's cobblestones and castle ramparts to the fairways of the Home of Golf. Five nights, two rounds, and a story you will tell for years.
