Avignon: Your Provençal Base

TGV to Paris: Through the French Countryside

Sit back and watch the French countryside unfold as you travel aboard the TGV high-speed train from Avignon to Paris. In just 2.5 hours, you'll glide past patchwork vineyards, medieval villages, and sunlit fields that gradually give way to the elegance of the French capital, a scenic and effortless transition from Provence's pastoral charm to Parisian sophistication.

Paris: Art, Culture, and Timeless Charm

Enjoy two unforgettable nights in a Prestige Room at Hôtel Louison, a refined boutique hotel in Paris' elegant 6th arrondissement. Once a noble residence, the Louison combines historic Parisian character with modern sophistication. Wake up to a delightful breakfast before stepping out to explore the nearby Luxembourg Gardens, Saint-Germain-des-Prés, and the Left Bank's timeless cafés.

Your journey culminates with a skip-the-line guided tour of the Musée d'Orsay, home to one of the world's most extraordinary collections of Impressionist and Post-Impressionist art. As your expert

guide leads you through its grand galleries, you'll take in masterworks from Monet, Renoir, Degas, and Van Gogh, among many others, each offering a different window into the art movements that transformed painting in the nineteenth century.

Close out the trip with a quiet moment to reflect on the journey, from the sun-dappled vineyards of southern France to the art-filled halls of Paris, a story of good wine, rich history, and unforgettable scenery from start to finish.
